- Iron padlocks**
Stronger than steel, mainly for privacy purposes.
- Brass padlocks**
Stronger than steel, for low security purposes.
- Laminated padlocks**
Stronger than steel, made of laminated plates.
- Combination padlocks**
For privacy purposes, does not need a key.
- Weatherproof locks**
For outdoor use to keep dirt out.
- Shrouded padlocks**
Protected shrouds to prevent tampering.
- Insurance padlocks**
High-strength locks for higher security purposes.
- Discus padlocks**
High-strength locks that are more difficult to saw or cut.

Keyed Alike (KA) padlocks



A selection of Fort Knox padlocks are available in sets of multiple locks that all use the same key. These are ideal for situations where a number of locks are needed but having multiple keys is a burden.

What do the ratings mean?

- Good:** Mainly privacy locks, lockers, suitcases, luggage, bag tags etc.
- Best:** General use + higher security. Security gates, screens etc.
- Better:** General use + entry level security. Toolboxes, toolboxes etc.
- Specialised:** Unique features for specific applications. High rise security gates, gate motors etc.

- 2-Lever mortise locks**
Ideal for indoor and outdoor use where privacy is the primary concern, such as bathrooms, bedrooms etc.
- 3-Lever mortise locks**
Used indoor and outdoor where security is increasingly important to 3-Lever locks offer greater resistance to picking than 2-Lever locks.

- Euro Profile mortise locks**
Euro profile locks offer greater resistance to picking than 2 or 3-Lever locks. These locks use a special key for the lock which can be rekeyed.

Spare Keys
Duplicate and replacement keys for 2-Lever and 3-Lever locks can be purchased. Be sure to know the type of key you require.
